Assessment Results



The Year 6 SATs results landed earlier this week and are a crucial measure regarding the effectiveness of the

school. We were delighted with the results – which were the best the school has on record! Some highlights from the results were the fact that 100% of pupils achieved the expected standard in maths, 93% did so in reading, 86% in writing and 93% met the standard in grammar and spelling. All the results were significantly above the national average! Well done to the children, TAs and Class Teachers for this amazing set of results.
